Make Your Own Snowflake!

Materials Needed:

- Cardboard toilet paper tube
- Scissors
- Hot glue or staples
- Markers, paint, or glitter for decoration

Instructions:

1. Flatten your toilet paper tube.
2. Using scissors, cut 6 strips that are about an inch wide (see image)
3. Lay out these strips so they form a snowflake shape (see image).
4. Use glue or staples to attach the strips together at the center and the sides, as needed.
5. Decorate and display as you like!
