

What can you notice when you look closely?

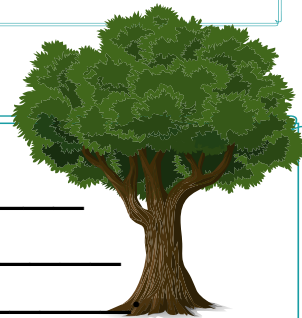


Now take a BIG step back and look at each tree from far away.
